WORKFLOW PRINCIPLES

1. DO THINGS *ONCE*, EFFICIENTLY

2. DO THINGS AUTOMATICALLY WHENEVER POSSIBLE.

3. START WITH THE GENERAL AND PROCEED TO THE SPECIFIC.
 - a. THAT IS, START WITH THE THINGS THAT CAN BE DONE TO THE GREATEST NUMBER OF IMAGES,
 - b. AND PROCEED TO MAKE INCREASINGLY MORE DETAILED TREATMENTS OF EVER-DECREASING NUMBERS OF IMAGES,
 - c. RESERVING THE FULL TREATMENT – CAREFUL HAND-EDITING IN CAMERA RAW AND PHOTOSHOP TO THOSE IMAGES THAT TRULY DESERVE THE ATTENTION.
